Ephesians 3:14-21

Context

- Who wrote this letter? [Ephesians 1:1]
- What had God done for those that Paul wrote to? [Ephesians 1:4, 2:4-5]
- What is also available for the Gentiles (non-Jews) [Ephesians 3:6]

Characters

- Who made Paul a minister? Why was this God's grace? How was God's power involved? [Ephesians 3:7, Acts 9:1-19]
 - Why might Paul think of himself as being least? [Ephesians 3:8a, Acts 8:1, Acts 9:1]
- How is the message that Paul has been sent to proclaim to the Gentiles described? [Ephesians 3:8b]
- What is Paul's task? [Ephesians 3:9]
 - Why have the people not been able to see this mystery before?
- Who created all things? [Ephesians 3:9]
 - How did God intend to reveal his wisdom? [Ephesians 3:10]
 - Who is God's wisdom made clear to? How is the Church involved in this? [Ephesians 3:10]
- What is the significance of Jesus coming to save sinners? [Ephesians 3:11]
- What is the relationship between the Christians that Paul wrote to and Jesus? [Ephesians 3:12]
 - What is found in Jesus? Why is this needed by the Christians that Paul wrote to and Paul himself?

Application

- How did God deal with Paul? What does this suggest about God's character?
- What can we find in Jesus?
 - How does this help us to keep following Jesus?
- How should we respond to God?
 - He has made the gospel clear to us.
 - He reveals his wisdom to the angelic host through the church.
